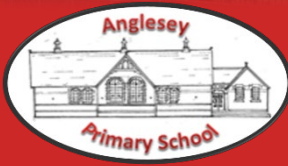

How to Book ?

For Boys & Girls
5-16 Years Old



STEP 1:
REGISTER YOUR CHILD USING THE QR CODE PROVIDED. IF YOUR CHILD IS ELIGIBLE FOR FREE SCHOOL MEALS (FSM), PROCEED DIRECTLY TO STEP 3.
IF YOUR CHILD IS NOT ELIGIBLE FOR FSM, CONTINUE TO STEP 2.

STEP 2:
A CODE WILL BE REQUESTED. IF YOUR CHILD IS ELIGIBLE FOR FSM, COLLECT CODE FROM SCHOOL.
IF YOUR CHILD IS NOT ELIGIBLE FOR FSM PLEASE ENTER 'NONE'.

STEP 3:
YOU SHOULD RECEIVE A CONFIRMATION EMAIL REGARDING YOUR SELECTED SESSIONS.
MAKE PAYMENT USING THE PAYMENT LINK PROVIDED.

STEP 4:
ALL CHILDREN ARRIVE AT THEIR ALLOCATED PLAYSCHEME SITE.

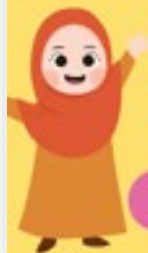
