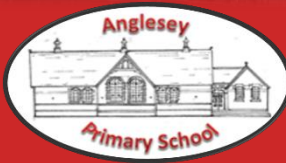

6C and 6Z visited the Apple Shop - exploring new technology and learning how to do some really cool technology related stuff!





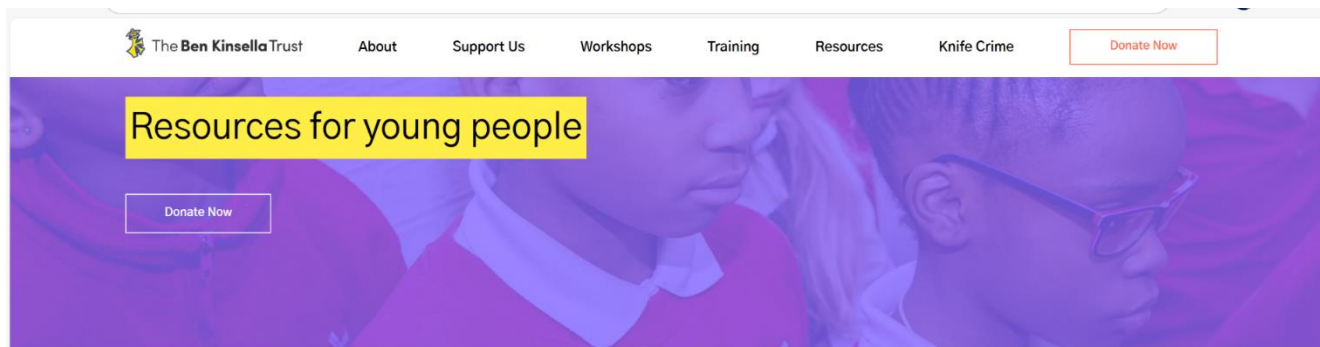
LITTER PICKING
