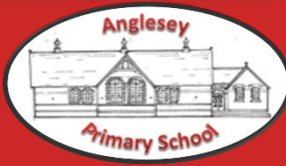

Dear Mr Pembleton

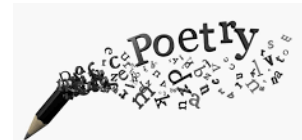

Year 5 have been making their own pizzas for their Design and Technology project. They look delicious!



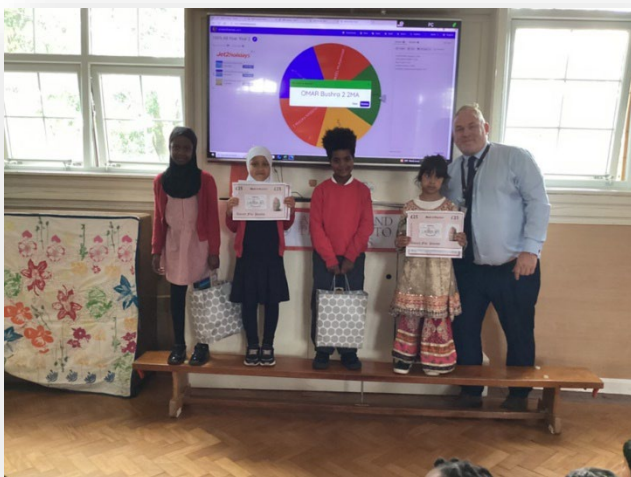
