During Attention Autism Bucket we made a face using fruit and vegetables.

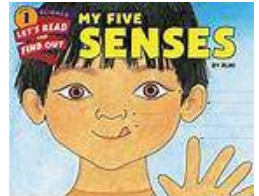


For our Sensory Story we read a book called
