## RECEPTION YOGA BUGS

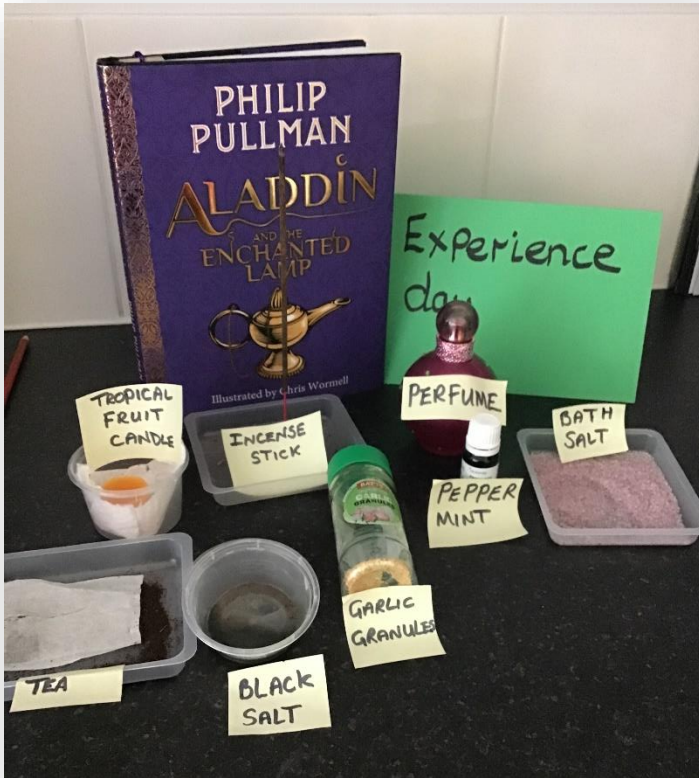
This week Reception children began **Yogabugs**.

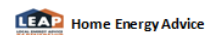

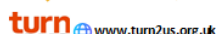
