Our school has been selected to proudly represent Aston in the HMS Birmingham Shield (9-a-side, mixed teams).

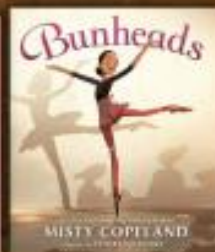
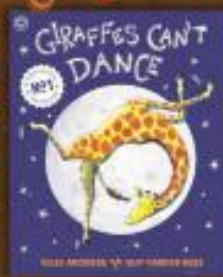
