All of the classes will be given the opportunity to go themselves and join the library. This will give the children a great opportunity to access and read lots of different books.



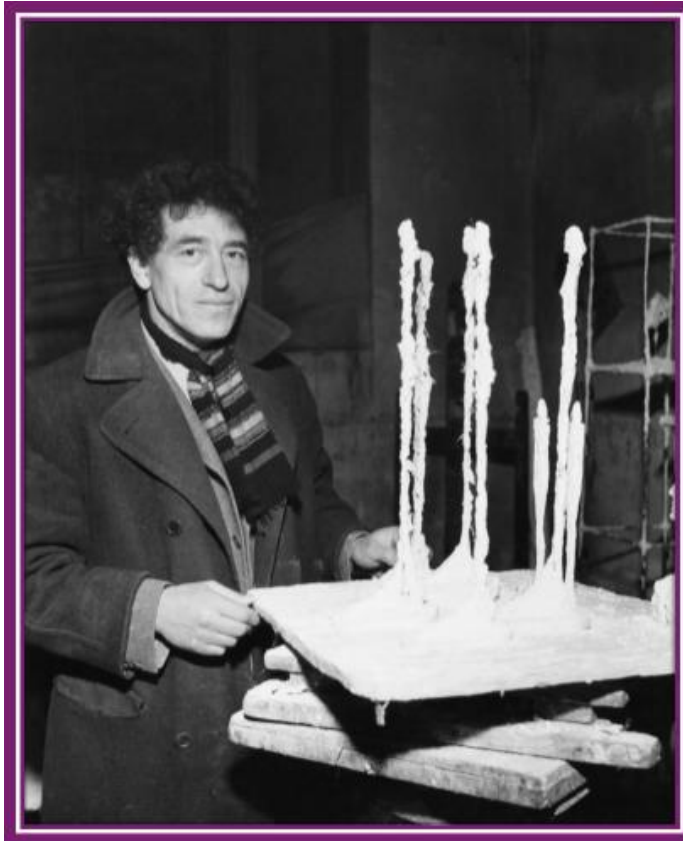
## SATS MEETING

Mrs Roberts-Lawler and the children in Y3 have been studying the sculptor Alberto Giacometti and replicated his art with their own designs.

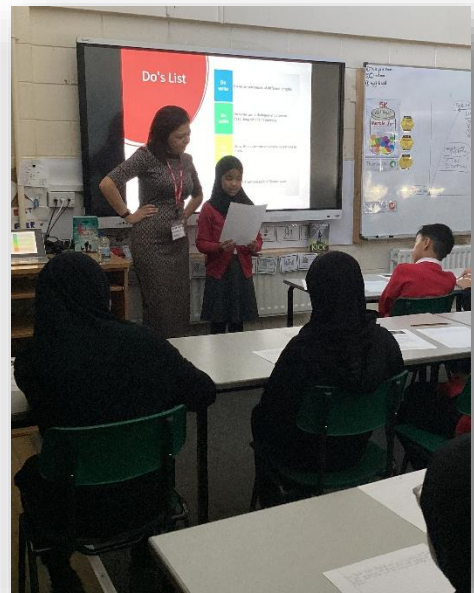

World Autism Acceptance Month school resources for April.

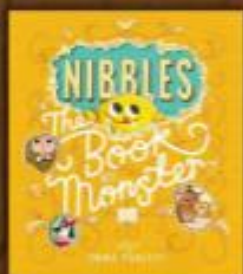
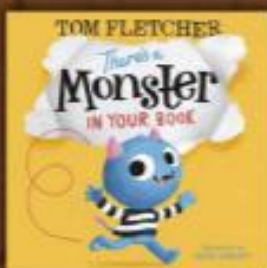
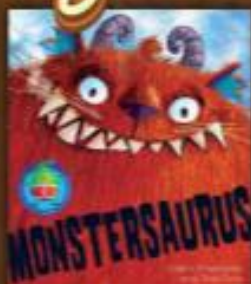
